Last year, we reported that GACC had moved to the third phase in our timeline, that we started worshipping weekly and launched a few more small ministries. It is an honor to report that we have been able to continue to Worship every Sunday, we did our first successful three-day Revival which was attended by hundreds of people both in person and online. We had a successful first Cross-Over service on the night of December 31, 2023, and season two of Love Day. We have expanded the driving classes program to support our members, end the transport challenge we have been facing, and strengthen existing ministries.

This year, we launched a few more ministries, including Music Classes for all ages, which resulted in a wonderful children's Band, we started the Wellness Fund, through which members of GACC members support each other financially. We are in the final stages of establishing cell groups - an effective church development/ growth strategy utilized by the Anglican Church of Tanzania.

We have launched a professional studio to help us do more online evangelism, support African immigrants who cannot afford to pay for studio sessions, and raise funds to support our mission and vision.

Through the generosity of our partner Organizations, this year, GACC awarded Scholarships to African International Students to cover books and Stationery. We thank God that we have maintained these partnerships while creating new ones.

We plan to continue strengthening existing ministries and maintaining the pace of growth and community development. October 23, 2024, marks the second year since GACC was launched. We are so grateful for Bishop Deon K. Johnson, The Diocese of Missouri, Churches, Organizations, and individuals who have supported us tirelessly. Most importantly, we are so thankful to God who has brought us this far.
