This letter contains important information about The Episcopal Church Medical Trust (Medical Trust) 2025 health benefits. Please read it carefully. Our online Annual Enrollment for your 2025 health benefits will run from October 16 - November 15.

## Medical Plans - Plans going away

We will no longer offer the following plans in 2025:

Anthem BCBS BlueCard PPO 100 and Cigna Open Access Plus PPO 100

IF YOU ARE CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN ONE OF THESE PLANS, YOU MUST SELECT ANOTHER PLAN TO CONTINUE MEDICAL COVERAGE IN 2025. FAILURE TO TAKE ACTION WILL RESULT IN NO MEDICAL COVERAGE FOR 2025.

The same dental plan options will be available to you in 2025

# Changes for 2025

Deductible increase for Anthem and Cigna CDHP-20	The IRS increased the minimum amount that a high-deductible health plan (HDHP) must impose as a deductible. (Note that the Medical Trust refers to HDHPs as CDHPs.)
	For 2025, the minimum amounts that must be imposed as deductibles under an HDHP are \$1,650 for self-only coverage and \$3,300 for family coverage. The amounts for 2024 were \$1,600 and \$3,200, respectively.

	9.3% of the Medical Trust's
	prescription drug costs. This was a
	295% increase over 2022 in our
	costs for GLP-1 agonists used as
	weight-loss medications. During the
	same period, our peers in the
	Church Benefits Association's
	coalition with Express Scripts
	experienced a 193% increase in the cost of these drugs when used
	for losing weight.
	To manage these costs and ensure
	these drugs are used appropriately,
	the Medical Trust is introducing the
	EncircleRx program with Express Scripts, which:
	ensures that medical data
	and documentation are on
	file for the use of GLP-1 in
	diabetes

## If You Are Currently Enrolled in a Medical Trust Pan

You will receive an Annual Enrollment letter in a green envelope approximately one week before Annual Enrollment begins. This letter will include information about how to access the enrollment site and your Annual Enrollment dates. Please save this letter. Whether or not you plan to make a change, be sure to log in to MyCPG Accounts and check that personal information is correct for yourself and your dependents. You can submit any corrections through MyCPG Accounts.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** For 2025, you will use the same credentials (associated email address and password) you created on MyCPG Accounts to access the Annual Enrollment page. If you have not already created an account on MyCPG Accounts, please do so before Annual Enrollment begins. As part of CPG's ongoing efforts to strengthen its online security, usernames are no longer accepted to access MyCPG Accounts. As of February 2023, you must enter the email address and password associated with your account to access MyCPG.

#### Not a Member and Want to Enroll?

If you are not currently participating in a Medical Trust plan and would like to enroll, please review the plan options attached. Then go online to www.cpg.org, hover over Benefits, select Active Clergy or Lay, then select Health to explore the plans and benefits. You will not receive a letter from the Medical Trust or be able to access Annual Enrollment through MyCPG, so please contact us to request an enrollment form and a copy of the Summaries of Benefits and Coverage and other important notices, or to ask any questions. If you take no action, your previous decision to decline coverage will remain in effect for 2025.

### **Employee Assistance Program (EAP) with Cigna Behavioral Health**

In addition to the Medical Trust health plans, your employer also offers a stand-alone EAP with Cigna for qualified employees who have spousal or other qualified coverage that is not through the Medical Trust. (The EAP is already included as part of each medical plan offering). This program covers your entire household, and is paid for by your employer.

Begin to review your options now if you plan to make a change or newly enroll in a Medical Trust plan to allow yourself time to make an informed decision. This is also the time of year when you may add or remove eligible dependents without a qualifying event.

During Annual Enrollment, Quantum will be available at 866-871-0629 to Anthem and Cigna members (and potential members) who want help reviewing existing benefits, understanding plan options, and choosing the right plan for themselves and their families.
